Photography

This ministry involves taking pictures of new members, various activities, publicity and promotion.

Office Aides / Guest Services

Welcoming guests, delivery personnel, etc. during weekday business office hours. Also assisting the office staff by volunteering time to help with office needs throughout the week with tasks such as telephones, copying, etc.

Activities

This ministry provides the organization and operation of all athletic and recreation leagues and events at OCC by serving a variety of ways (league coordinator, coaching, referee, umpires, score keeper, etc.)

Building Maintenance

Oversee and provide upkeep and maintenance of the entire building structure and mechanical equipment. (HVAC, plumbing, painting, floors, electrical, drywall, etc.)

Cleaning

Maintaining the appearance of the facilities through general cleaning.

Grounds Maintenance

Oversee and provide upkeep and maintenance of the entire church campus grounds and landscaping equipment; (mowing, trimming, snow and ice removal, parking lot & lighting, etc)

Safety Team

This team provides building security and lockup throughout the week and is available to help maintain safety and security at the services of OCC, and provide assistance to the medical team with any emergency medical needs.

Food Bank

Maintain the food closet and oversee the food stock supplies making sure there is adequate and available food for those our Family & Community care ministry help with their physical needs.

Harvesters

This ministry team contacts first time visitors with a phone call thanking them for worshipping with us and inviting them to return.

Baptism

This team provides assistance to those who will be baptized by helping them prepare for their baptism.

Communion

Preparation and clean up of the emblems (bread and juice) served to the church body for the Lords' supper.

Decision Counseling

Assist those coming forward to make a decision on Sunday mornings by taking them to a counseling room to talk and pray with them about their decision.

☐ Servers

Serving the body by passing the Lord's Supper (juice and bread trays) and the collection of the tithes and offerings.

☐ Greeters

Open doors, hand out bulletins and greet members and guests who enter into our worship service with a warm welcome and smile.

☐ Information Center

Provide assistance to our members and guests at our Information center booth by answering questions or supplying any needed information or directions.

☐ Ushers

Provide assistance to those entering the service and throughout the service in a variety of ways: seating people, passing out and collecting attendance booklets, count attendance, being aware and helping those in need during the service, etc.

☐ Medical Response

Provide emergency care for the adults and children who are attending the services of OCC. This team also serves as a bridge for stabilization until the situation is no longer an emergency or it is determined that advanced treatment is required.

☐ Drama

An avenue used to communicate the gospel in a relevant and creative manner through short plays or sketches during our worship services and through seasonal productions.

☐ Instrumental

A ministry that provides opportunities for those with abilities to play an instrument to contribute to our worship services and productions through a worship orchestra or rhythm section.

☐ Productions

Provide support to all productions for adult and youth by building sets, publicity, choreography, set design, computer graphics, etc.

☐ Technical (A/V)

Provide support to all corporate assemblies of OCC in the areas of audio, video, visuals, lighting, and PowerPoint presentations.

☐ Vocal

An avenue to communicate the gospel in worship assemblies and seasonal productions through singing in a choir or praise team.

☐ Senior Adults

A ministry that strives to meet the spiritual and relational needs of senior adults in the areas of fellowship, Bible study, and various activities.

☐ Women

A ministry that strives to meet the spiritual and relational needs of women of the OCC family and visitors through Bible studies, activities, outreach projects, etc.

☐ Crib Nursery

These teams provide a warm and loving environment by caring for the infant babies of OCC members and guests during services

☐ Crawler Nursery

These teams provide a warm and loving environment by caring for the crawler babies of OCC members and guests during services

Toddler Nursery

Provides a warm and loving environment by caring for the toddler babies of OCC members and guests during services.

WEE Educate

Works with children between the ages of 2-5 years of age in a Sunday morning setting by teaching, assisting, recruiting volunteers, organizing curriculum, crafts, etc.

WEE Celebrate

Working with children in a worship time geared for children between the ages of 2-5 through drama, puppets, music, games, video, snacks etc.

WEE Rock

This ministry works with children between the ages of 2-5 in a Wednesday night setting by teaching, assisting, setup and take down, crafts, serving as a chaperone or an organizer at an activity, etc.

Elementary Education

Work with children between the ages of 1st - 5th grade on Sunday morning by teaching, assisting, organizing curriculum, crafts, etc.

KIDS Celebrate

Work with children between the ages of 1st - 5th grade in a Sunday morning worship setting in a variety of ways: teaching, singing, drama, greeting, audio or video, set up and take down, etc.

W.O.W. (Worship On Wednesday)

Work with children between the ages of 1st - 5th grade on Wednesday night by teaching, assisting, set up and take down, crafts, serving as a chaperone or organizer of an activity, etc.

Vacation Bible School

A high impact week of ministry designed to meet the needs of kids in the church and our community. There are numerous ways you can serve in this ministry. A few are: teaching, assisting, recreation, crafts, music, snacks, drama, publicity, plus many others.

Middle School

A ministry of support and encouragement to middle school aged students through teaching, small group leader, helper, team leader, chaperone, activity organizer, etc. . .

High School

A ministry of support an encouragement to high school aged students through teaching, small group leader, helper, team leader, chaperone, activity organizer, etc . . .

Home Care

Provide Christian fellowship to those in our church family (who are temporarily or permanently confined to their homes or to a convalescent center) in a variety of ways such as communion, visits, phone calls, projects, cards and letters, transportation.

Hospital Visitation

Provide encouragement to members of OCC and their families who are in the hospital by visits, phone contacts and prayer.

Meals of Mercy

Provide a meal for those in our church family who have experienced the death of an immediate family member. Food preparation, phone calls, delivery of food, serving meal, set up of tables and chairs, clean up, etc.
