When asked why we memorize verses, she said "we have to keep them in our hearts, so that we can tell others about how much God loves them."

Not only does Devynn want to memorize Bible verses and asks lots of questions to better understand God, she is always looking out for mission opportunities and ways to give. A couple of months ago when we did the Baby Bottle Campaign, Devynn took home four empty baby bottles and brought them back filled with coins. Every Sunday in that month she would bring me her filled bottle and by the end of that Sunday she would show me a new empty bottle. Devynn loved collecting money, but also telling others about why she was collecting money. She knew exactly what she was giving money to and why.

The children at OCC are exceeding all expectations. They go above and beyond to love God and to love others. Devynn is just one story of many from Children's Ministry. As a church, let's pray that Devynn and other children never lose their innocent love for Jesus, because it is a beautiful thing.
