Song: The Veterinarian (Sung to: Oh, My Darlin)

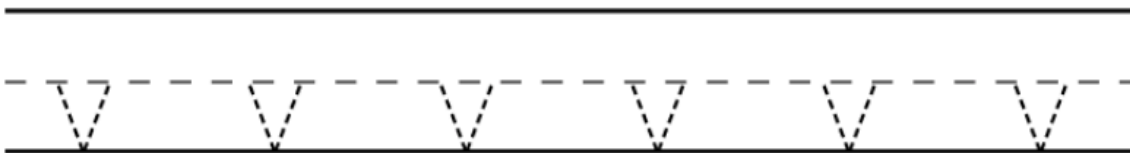
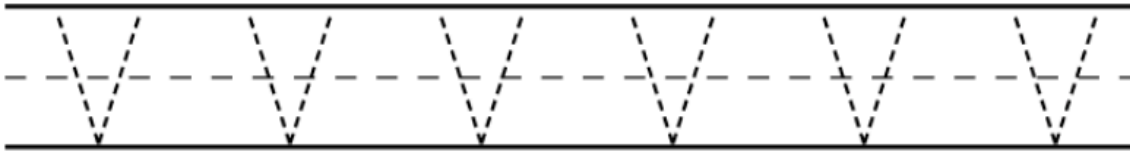
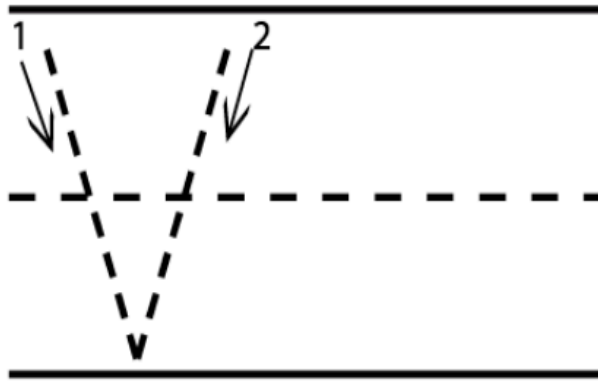
