## **Getting Started Questions For Those Who Are Single:**

- 1. Is there anything others may desire from you relationally that they are not getting from you?
- 2. Is there anything you do that hurts others or keeps you from developing relationships?
- 3. Is there something you used to do, in relation to others, that you wish you still did?
- 4. As a Single person, do you feel like there is an area in your life where God is missing?
- 5. What would you change about how you pursue God?

## **Digging Deeper In the Word**

Consider what the following Scriptures say about being Single:

- **1 Corinthians 7:6-9** <sup>6</sup>I say this as a concession, not as a command. <sup>7</sup>But I wish everyone were single, just as I am. Yet each person has a special gift from God, of one kind or another. <sup>8</sup>So I say to those who aren't married and to widows—it's better to stay unmarried, just as I am. <sup>9</sup>But if they can't control themselves, they should go ahead and marry. It's better to marry than to burn with lust.
- **1 Corinthians 7:27-28** <sup>27</sup> If you have a wife, do not seek to end the marriage. If you do not have a wife, do not seek to get married. <sup>28</sup> But if you do get married, it is not a sin. And if a young woman gets married, it is not a sin. However, those who get married at this time will have troubles, and I am trying to spare you those problems.
- 1 Corinthians 7:32-35 <sup>32</sup> I want you to be free from the concerns of this life. An unmarried man can spend his time doing the Lord's work and thinking how to please him. <sup>33</sup> But a married man has to think about his earthly responsibilities and how to please his wife. <sup>34</sup> His interests are divided. In the same way, a woman who is no longer married or has never been married can be devoted to the Lord and holy in body and in spirit. But a married woman has to think about her earthly responsibilities and how to please her husband. <sup>35</sup> I am saying this for your benefit, not to place restrictions on you. I want you to do whatever will help you serve the Lord best, with as few distractions as possible.
