5 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With Your Kids



Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Today in our Bible Story Paul and Barnabas went to Lystra to tell the people about Jesus. They met a man who could not walk. Paul knew that God could heal this man. He told the man to get up and walk and God healed him. When missionaries like Paul and Barnabas go to cities and countries to tell people about Jesus, they look for ways they can help. They want to show the people that God loves them. God loves everyone. He wants everyone to know Jesus because THE WHOLE WORLD NEEDS JESUS.



Make this week's lesson real:

Pray with your kids this week for the people of Japan, China, Korea, and the Philippines. Pray that God will protect the missionaries and the Christians there and that the word of God will be shared, and lives will continue to be changed.
