Pre-school Public Registration Opens April 8, 2025

Registration will begin on April 8th. Be sure to sign up right away! Spots for next year will fill up very fast, signing up early will ensure a spot for child next year at OCP. Please complete the following steps in order to ensure proper registration for the 2025-2026 School Year. Please use the QR code below to register.



1. Review OCP Handbook

2. Register & Pay a Non-refundable Registration Fee
complete your child's Information questionnaire. Once complete, there will be a one-time, non-refundable registration fee payment due for \$125. This non-refundable fee secures your child's preschool placement for next year. The non-refundable fee also covers school supplies, snacks, and special guests who visit us at school. Please note all students must re-enroll for the upcoming 2025-2026 school year.

3. Set-up Recurring Monthly Tuition Payments
The tuition rate for the upcoming year is \$1800. Please set up monthly recurring payments in the amount of \$200 for each month. Tuition payments will begin September 1, 2025 and run through May 1, 2026.
